

OPENING OF ARMY LAW COLLEGE AT KANHE, PUNE (MAHARASHTRA)
FROM JUL/AUG 2018

1. Army Law College (ALC), Kanhe is being established at Kanhe Pune (Maharashtra) on Old Pune – Mumbai Highway approx 40 Kms from Pune Railway Station and 50 Kms from Airport under the aegis of HQ Southern Comd.
2. **Degree Course.** ALC will provide BBA – LLB (5 years Integrated Course) affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU), Pune.
3. **Academic Session.** Academic Session 2018-19 will commence wef Jul/Aug 2018 for 1st year BBA LLB integrated Course.
4. **Seats.** 60.

Eligibility

5. Applicant should have passed Senior Secondary (Class XII) with min 50% in any stream. Wards of following category can apply :-
 - (a) Children of serving Army personnels with minimum 10 years continues service in Army.
 - (b) Children of ex Army personnel granted/awarded regular pension, liberalised family pension, family pension or disability pension at the time of their superannuation, demise, discharge, release medical board/invalided medical board. This includes children of recruits medically boarded out and granted disability pension.
 - (c) Children of ex Army personnel who have taken discharge/release after ten years of service.
7. **Adopted/Step Children and Children of Remarried Widows.**
 - (a) Adopted child of Army personnel adopted at least five years prior to seeking admission.
 - (b) Step children are eligible provided they are born out of a wedding where at least one parent belonged to the Army.
 - (c) Children of widows of Army personnel who are born as a result of second marriage with Army personnel. However, children of widows of Army personnel born out of remarriage with Non-Army personnel would not be eligible for admission.
8. **Eligibility Criteria in Special Case.**
 - (a) **Eligibility Criteria for Children of Ex Army Medical Corps Officers/Army Dental Corps Offrs Presently Serving with IN/IAF.** Children of only those ex Army medical offrs / Army Dental Corps offrs presently serving with Indian Navy or Indian Air Force who have served with the Army for 10 years.

(b) **Eligibility Criteria for Children of APS Personnel.**

(i) Children of APS personnel classified as ex-servicemen as per Government of India, Ministry of Defence letter No 9(52)/88/D(Res) dated 19 Jul 89.

(ii) Children of those APS personnel who are on deputation and who have put in 10 years of service in the Army.

(iii) Children of APS personnel who are directly recruited into APS and of those who, as per their terms and conditions of service, retired from APS after completing their minimum pensionable service.

(a) **Eligibility Criteria for Children of MNS/TA Personnel.** The following are eligible:-

(i) Children of only those members of MNS who have 10 years service as regular members of MNS or are in receipt of pension from the Army.

(ii) Children of only those TA personnel who have completed 10 years of embodied service.

9. **Filling of Unsubscribed Seats.** Unsubscribed seats from those meant for Army wards will be filled as follows:-

(a) **Priority One.** Wards of ex Army personnel who have continuous service between 5 to 10 years in Army.

(b) **Priority Two.** Wards of personnel of Assam Rifles.

10. **Definition of Dependent Children.** Dependent children are defined as sons/daughters till marriage or employment which ever is earlier.

11. **Prospectus of College.** Prospectus is under publication. Cost of Prospectus alongwith application form is Rs 500/- and can be obtained from Dir AWES Cell, HQ Southern Comd, Pune on payment of Rs 500/- by a demand draft by hand. Postage charges will be applicable if demanded by post.

12. **Admission.** Through MH CET conducted by Savitribai Phule Pune University. MH CET Exam is scheduled tentatively on 22 Apr 2018. On-line applications will commence on 26 Feb 2018.
